



Command Sergeant Major Jeremy A. Gebhardt was the Commandant for Headquarters, North American Aerospace Defense Command and United States Northern Command.

Command Sergeant Major Gebhardt is a native of Nashville, Tennessee where he enlisted in the United States Army in August 1994 and completed One Station Unit Training (OSUT) at Fort Benning, Georgia.

Meade, MD; and as the Battalion Command Sergeant Major, 2-502 IN REGT, Fort Campbell, KY. Throughout his career, CSM Gebhardt has deployed to Bosnia-Herzegovina, 3 combat tours to Iraq as well as 4 tours to Afghanistan among other global deployments.
